In *The Bélier Family*, everyone is deaf, except dutiful sixteen-year-old Paula. She is a crucial member of the family, as an indispensable interpreter for her parents and younger brother, especially in the running of the family dairy farm. However, Paula's attentions are very much elsewhere, she's witnessed the handsome new boy at school sign up for the choir, and impulsively joined too.

It's not long before her music teacher discovers her considerable talent, however his encouragement only highlights the struggle between the interdependence of the family on Paula and her dream of independence. The film takes you on a roller coaster ride of emotion, no wonder it was France's most popular film of 2015.
