This month's classic film on the **27th July 2016** is *Cat on a Hot Tin Roof* 1958.

*Cat on a Hot Tin Roof* is a play by Tennessee Williams and is one of the giants of twentieth-century drama. One era is ending, how does the next begin? It is a portrait of two generations. One doesn't want to die, and the other one feels crowded out, confused, and desperate to inherit whatever it can get before it's too late.

*Cat on a Hot Tin Roof* is a story of brothers vying for their dying father's inheritance amid a whirlwind of sexuality, untethered in the person of Maggie the Cat, played by Elizabeth Taylor. The play also daringly showcased the burden of sexuality repressed in the agony of her husband, Brick Pollitt. It is a play that examines candour, falsehoods and untruths, sensuality, power, and the angst humans have in dealing with death.

The play written in 1955, still has relevance in the issues it raises, although shown in a very different manner than how it would be portrayed today. A film not to be missed even if you have seen it in the past.
